King and Her Majesty The Queen Consort is a time for celebration across the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth, and a weekend of special events is planned.

On Saturday 6 May the Coronation Ceremony takes place at Westminster Abbey, London, Venues on Ynys Môn, like the Ucheldre Centre in Holyhead and Cefni Craft Fair in Llangefni, will be hosting public screenings of the event. Many local people will be watching the ceremony on television and enjoying what, for some of us, will be a once-in-a-lifetime event.

On Monday 8 May a special Bank Holiday has been proclaimed by our Prime Minister in honour of the Coronation. This means that we have a long weekend to join in with community events and celebrate.
